ALMA HEPBURN WALKINS was born on April 23, 1936, in Stevenson, Cat Island, Bahamas, to the late Leon and Roxana Poitier Hepburn. She grew up in Bluff, Cat Island, where she attended Bluff All Age School. Alma accepted the Lord as her personal Savior at an early age. She later moved to Nassau, New Providence, Bahamas, to further her employment opportunities.

In March of 1962, Alma married the late Calfred Joseph Walkins, in Nassau, Bahamas. The couple migrated to the United States in 1963, initially living in Hallandale Beach, Florida. They later moved to West Park, Florida. Upon moving to South Florida, she became a member of Hallandale Church of God, where she worshipped until her demise. Over the years, Alma served in various capacities and ministries at her local church, including: Church Usher, Sunday School Teacher, Prayer Band Leader, Lay Minister, Women's Discipleship, and Church Mother.

In her vocational capacity, Alma worked for over forty years as a Certified Nurses' Assistant at Memorial Regional Hospital. Upon retirement, she assisted in the rearing of her granddaughter, Jasmine Holly. Her favorite pastimes included sewing, knitting and crocheting, fishing, gardening, and

baking.

Having fought a valiant fight, and leaving behind all aches, pain and illness, Alma transitioned to her heavenly home, on July 23, 2023, at her residence in Pembroke Pines, Florida.
