Charles was affectionately called "Uncle Charlie/Uncle Charger" by his family and friends.

Charles's early educational training was completed at BF James Elementary School, McNichols Middle School and Hallandale High School.

Charles participated in various sports. He was a member of the Track Team and ran (long-distance events). He won many awards and trophies for his skillful actions.

Charles's life was dedicated to Christ at an early age as he attended Greater Ward Chapel A.M.E. Church with his Mother and Father on a regular basis.

Charles enjoyed and mastered the Art of Horticulture and he worked with his

Father and Brothers in the Family Nursery/Landscaping Business (Stafford's Nursery). Charles was also fascinated with Biking and Motorcycling.

In 1976, at the tender age of 16, Charles was severely injured in a "Motorcycle" accident, which caused him limited and physical disabilities. He remained in the care of his parents until their demise. In 2003, Charles resided with his Brother and Sister-in-law and remained in the care of his entire loving Family, until he answered the Master's call to Glory on Tuesday, June 6, 2023.

Charles interacted with the Family in many ways. He was very smart with a vibrant sense of humor, humble, grateful, thankful, unique and had a great personality. He loved and enjoyed all his 70's music...We could always count on him to "DJ" at the small Family gatherings. Charles enjoyed traveling with family on vacations to Disney World, Basketball State Championships, Family Reunions and Motorcycle Events.

Charles was also a skillful Artist and Master of Arts & Craft. He has many, many years of Coloring Books. Some of his pictures were donated to a Women's Correctional Institute, (laminated, and used as place mats). They were donated to the "Women Prison Ministry" by his caregiver, this act of kindness was an inspirational and blessing to others.

Charles will always be remembered and loved for his infectious smile, thoughtfulness for the concern of others, unconditional love, humble and sweet personality. Through all his pain and limited disabilities, he never ever complained.

Yes, Charles fought a good fight! He kept the faith and in accordance with God's will on Tuesday, June 6, 2023, at 10:32 a.m. at Hollywood Memorial Regional South "Accent Hospice Care Unit", 3rd Floor Room 330, he

answered the Master's call to come home to Eternal and Everlasting Life.

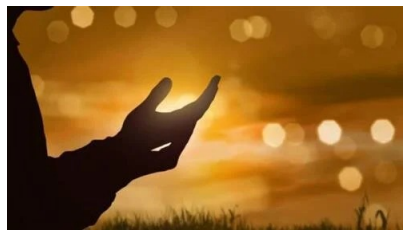
