No matter if I worked a closing shift or if I was tired or mentally exhausted, talking to her always made me forget everything bad that was going on. The last time we FaceTimed, she felt so bad that she hadn’t FaceTimed me in like 2 months. I wasn’t even mad, I just wanted her to focus on her health and to know she was okay. Those 6 minutes we talked really made my whole day. Ciente was one of the strongest people I knew next to my mother. She never let her battle with cancer keep her down or stop her from keeping the positive attitude and outlook she always had. She was quite honestly one of the most important people in my life and a pillar I could always lean on through all the ups and downs of life. She was one of the very few people in this world who truly understood me and who I didn’t care about trying to keep up appearances in front of. Someone who had such a way with words and who taught me many things about life. This doesn’t even scratch the surface of how wonderful of a person

Ciante Wright was. Ciante was just too good for this world. She really was such a precious gem to have in your life. Life truly is not the same without her, but I'll always keep with me in my heart all the memories and lessons she instilled in me. We were supposed to finally meet in person this year, but we sadly didn't have that opportunity.
