Horace Kerr was born in the beautiful and balmy country of Montego Bay Jamaica, on the 21st day of June 1943, to loving parents: Albert and Violet Kerr. He was the 6th of 10 children (Rhuel, Carmen, Oswald, Slater, and Ronald preceded him in death).

He received his formal education in Jamaica. As a young man he married, and of that union were born 2 sons, Mark and Marlon Kerr.

In 1981 he traveled to New York in the United States, where he resided for a time.

In 1983, he decided to move to Miami, Florida to settle and pursue life, first becoming a legal resident and appropriately following a citizen of his new country.

In 1985 Horace married again, and shortly after was baptized in, and became a dutiful member of St. Matthew Missionary Baptist Church, where he served as a member of the male chorus.

Horace was a heavy equipment operator and tractor-trailer driver for the Brewer/DeMoya company until he retired in 2012.

In March of 2013 he became disabled as the result of a motor vehicle accident. Due to overwhelming health challenges, he was recently admitted to the hospital, and on Friday, August 18, 2023, our LORD and SAVIOUR called him home to rest.
