Ronald started a career with the City of Miami Beach where he retired after 26 1/2 years of service. Then he went back to work as a Dade County School Bus Driver where he retired after 14 years. He was a great family man. When it came to providing and gathering with family and friends, if you needed anything Ronald could not tell you No. He had a heart of gold. Everyone was always happy when they knew Ronald was going to be in their presence.
