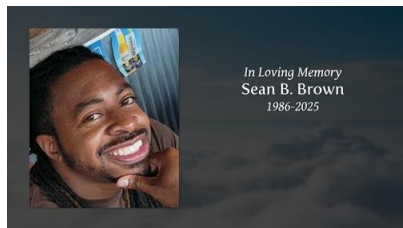

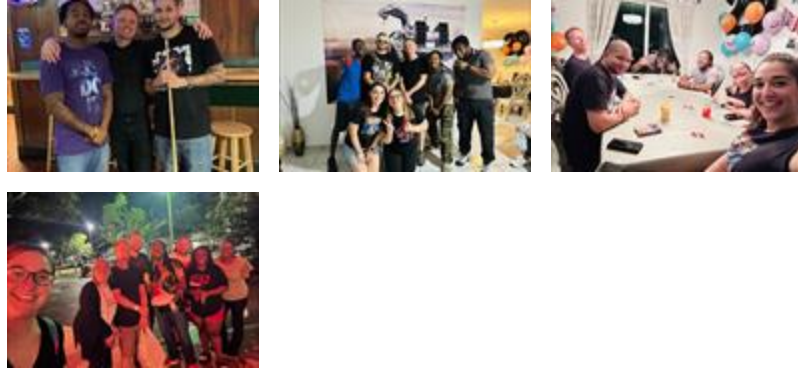

“Peace exists. It lives in everything we hold dear. That is the promise of peace — one day, after a long life, you find each other again.” ~Elena Gilbert

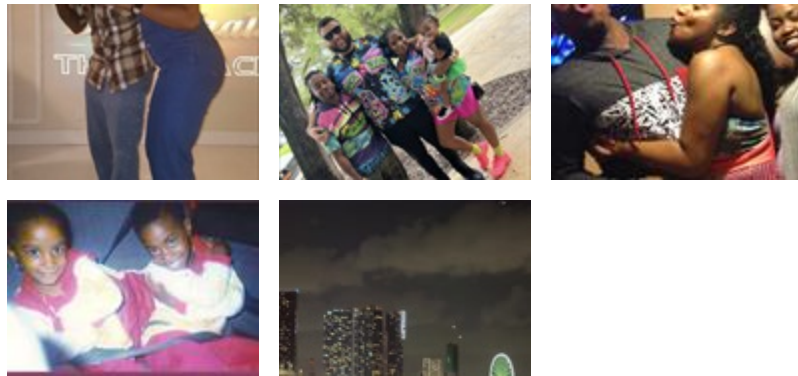
