There was no boy chore or girl chore in the home; thus, he learned to cook clean wash, and care for the plants and animals, He reared some of the best rabbits always coming home with a bundle of rabbit feed.

Childhood, life revolved around. home, school, and church. It was school Monday to Friday and church on Sundays no questions no excuses. Venine was an active member of the Springfield Moravian Church youth group; "The Boys Brigade". He was an active participant in drills and various competitions. Winning Sometimes.

Venine attended the Springfield All-Age School up to the age of 15. He was successful in the entrance exam to attend St Andrew Technical Trade Center in Kingston. He left home in the country to join his aunt Maudlyn's family in

Kingston to attend School where he was trained in Plumbing and Pipe Filling. It was while living with Aunt Maudlyn that he got the name "Posey". Posey would be the one to go to the post office at 3 miles which was some distance from home in Water House. This duty was extended to neighbors. After school, Posey and his cousin Vivian left home to work on their chosen craft. Posey lived and worked in several places. Some persons may know him from Kingston, Portland, up the street, or down the road, always giving a helping hand. As a single parent raising his family, Posey worked hard to always find a way to provide.

In 1994, Posey migrated to the United States, where he lived with his sister Cynthia. He promptly applied his specialized craft skills as a master plumber, securing employment. Posey's dedication to his work was unwavering, and he demonstrated a willingness to take on assignments wherever the job demanded.

April 1, 2001, was a joyous moment in Posey's life, as he married his cherished wife, Ruthlin Cooper, affectionately known as Rosie. A woman who truly embodies the essence of a rose, adding beauty and warmth to every moment of Posey's life, loving and caring for him. Posey also loved music, to party, and a good game of domino.
